REGISTRATION INFORMATION

REGISTRATION & PAYMENT

All Registration must be done online and requires online payment. Once you are finished registering for your activities, you will be required to complete payment using a credit/debit card. Participants will NOT be allowed to participate in an activity until payment and the program waiver have been completed.



REFUND POLICY

- •Explore It!...Students can write their own story and video game code, experiment with it and test new options. Our collaborative learning environment encourages students to learn from each other.


